DELBORELLO LEADS WANNEROO TO NATIONAL TITLES

Anthony Del Borello captained the Wanneroo District Cricket Club under 18 20/20 cricket team to victory over Gosnells at Kingsway on Sunday to not only win the WA championship but to take his team to Canberra to contest a national cricket championship in March.

Del Borello, a state under 19 representative, led his team from the front by scoring 43 runs and then taking 2/22 with his beguiling spin bowling.

The athletic 17 year old was clearly the man of the match but the support he received from his team mates had the Wanneroo supporters standing in ovation regularly during the game.

Kyle Millar brought on early in the opposition's innings used his spinning ability to take 2/18 off his 4 overs which added to his score of 44 runs has him in direct competition with his captain for man of the match honours.

James Di Carlo scored 28 not out to be second highest Wanneroo scorer and later took a catch low down off Del Borello's bowling that will be long be remembered by this young group of Wanneroo players.

This format of cricket again attracted a huge number of supporters to Kingsway and the enthusiasm of the crowd ensured a high standard of performance from the young players.

For Wanneroo the performance of the wicket keeper, James "Smokey" Dawson was outstanding while Stephen Wiggers with 1/18 and Justin Power, another Spinner, with 1/17 restricted the Gosnells players who had players capable of lusty hitting.

The success of the team and the quality of the cricket it played speaks volumes for the coaching policies put in place by head coach Brett Mulder.
